LtN Program Directors support the Country Director in all aspects of LtN programming.

Responsibilities include:

- Inspire youth to love, participate in and value sport (specifically lacrosse).
 - Act as a positive role model who demonstrates the character traits & life skills LtN teaches.
 - Plan and execute lacrosse and PE programming at LtN's home and partner sites.
 - Track and evaluate LtN's sports, scholarship, and education program metrics.
 - Identify, gather, and create content for LtN's marketing and digital communications.
 - Contribute to social media strategy for your LtN site.
 - Recruit and evaluate volunteers for your LtN site.
 - Host and assist in the management of short-term volunteers and summer interns.
 - Assist in the planning and execution of local fundraising initiatives and events.
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The ideal candidate for this role:

- Is a recent college graduate.
- Has strong Spanish language skills (conversational fluency).
- Has experience with or demonstrated interest in working with kids.
- Has a demonstrated interest in sports (especially lacrosse); experience in coaching is a plus.
- Has strong relationship-building and collaboration skills, both professionally and personally.
- Has high level of patience and flexibility.
- Demonstrates the ability to work autonomously, with limited direct supervision.
- Possesses excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrates the ability and willingness to work outdoors in an active setting.
